### Meldanda

- 1. Managed the volunteers, camp bookings, provision of materials and equipment and all necessary administrations including invoicing and banking for Meldanda. Kept neighbors informed of any camp bookings.
- 2. Volunteer Andy whipper snipped a track up to bat island and hand weeded Bushtucker garden and the fire garden. Volunteers Bob, Andy and Brenton did general maintenance and watering at Meldanda.
- 3. Volunteers saw the koala back at Meldanda again on the 17<sup>th</sup> November.

4. Volunteer Sharon White propagated some *Myoporum montanum, Hardenbergia violacea, Eucalyptus, Swainsona tephrotrica,* general maintenance including weeding, watering and unblocking sprinklers.

# River Murray International Dark Sky Reserve

- 16. We held our Dark Sky meeting in the Cambrai Council Chambers on 13<sup>th</sup> November.
- **17.** Chris Tugwell completed all the school sessions about the Dark Sky Reserve, there has been great interest from Swan Reach School to be more involved and would like an observatory there.

## Irongrass Grasslands Project

- 18. We have had 10.25mm of rain on the trial site at Meldanda in November. Contractor Andrew Fairney sprayed the caltrop that was coming up in the trial site on the 18/11/20.
- 19. Volunteers Brenton and Sheralee went to the wicking bed trial site to fill the barrels up with water and make sure the float system was working properly.
- 20. Nicola Barnes was our guest speaker at our AGM and talked to the group about the project and we visited the seed production areas.
- 21. Volunteers Sheralee, Brenton, Cryss and Aimee collected seed from the SPA; Walwhalleya, Austrostipa, Rytidosperma, Enneapogon, Anthosachne, Ptilotus spathulatus, Geranium retrorsum, Minuria, Goodenia and Chyrsocephalum. Tried the blower vacuum

for collecting seed and it is too difficult for the volunteers to use so bought a smaller unit that is easier for them to handle.

- 22. Volunteer Cryss Filsell helped out recording while Jo Clarke and Aimee Linke did the 3 days monitoring the Poonthie Ruwe site.
- 23. Set off to set up the trials north of Burra, only to be turned around thanks to COVID State Lock-down. We collected some seed before we came back to make it worth something.
- 24. Spent a week in Burra with extra helpers; Kate Graham, Nicola Barnes, Sarah Barnes, Rowena Danks and Aimee Linke to get all the trials set up north of Burra. We also collected seed opportunistically.

### Western Pygmy Possum

- 25. Picked up remote camera that was lent to landholder at Wellington East. There was some great photos of fauna but no WPP, there was one of a White-striped freetail bat.
- **26.** Site visit to landholder's property Sheralee Warren to inspect her boxes.
- **27.** Lent remote camera to landholder Peter Lee to set up on one of his WPP boxes.
